

Step 1:

Print the heart pattern and cut it out. If you cannot print the pattern, please make your own pattern creating a 7" heart.

Pattern can be found here: Lovies-Pattern.pdf (niculovies.org)

If you want to make the pattern more durable, trace the paper pattern on to something thicker such as cardstock, cardboard, a manila folder. You can also print directly on to cardstock if your printer can accommodate larger paper.

Step 2:

Trace the heart pattern on the back side of your fabric. You need to trace 4 hearts for every set. Then cut the fabric hearts out.

One Side of the Heart Needs to be a white or light solid color fabric so the nursing team can write inspirational messages and bible quotes on them.

The Other Side of the Heart can be a adulty, happy and whimsical fabric.

Step 3:

Place the two hearts together, right-sides in, and stich all around the heart, leaving a two-inch opening. Trim the extra fabric.

Step 4:

Turn the heart inside out using the opening you left. Then iron the heart flat.

Step 5:

Top-stitch the heart all the way around. The finished heart should be approximately 7 x 7 inches.
