PILLOWCASE, STANDARD – EASY INSTRUCTIONS

Material

1 yard, 44" wide, soft cotton or flannel, for one standard pillowcase

Directions

- 1. On 44" side, fold 1/2" down and press; then fold down 4 inches and press. (This is the "top" of the pillowcase.)
- 2. Open up this pressed edge.
- 3. Fold material right sides together (selvage edges together), match up all sides, pin if needed. (The edge you folded/pressed, is the "top" where the pillow will be inserted.)
- 4. Sew along the long side (36") and across bottom. Make sure you catch the selvages when they're a different color; often \sim 5/8" seam will work. Or use serger.
- 5. If the bottom seam edge is messy/raveling, you may want to zigzag it.
- 6. Clip bottom corners.
- 7. Turn
- 8. Fold down, to the inside, the 4" top along your press line, with the 1/2" pressed part tucked under. Pin and sew along the bottom edge about 1/4" seam.
- 9. Press pillowcase.
