Crochet Step Shawl Pattern

This pattern was adapted from *naztazia.com* to use 4-ply yarn and an H (5.0mm) hook, and to eliminate the fringe. Link to the original is here (with tutorial): *https://naztazia.com/crochet-step-shawl/*



Abbreviations:

CH = chain SC = single crochet DC = double crochet * = repeat instructions in parentheses

Supplies:

4-ply yarn (about 10 oz) H/8/5.0mm crochet hook

Instructions:

Row 1: CH 4. Skip 3 chains; DC into 4th chain. Do NOT turn.

Row 2: CH 4 (counts at 1 DC and 1 CH throughout). 3 DC in space in row 1 (between the chains and the double crochet). DC in first CH of row 1. Turn.

Row 3: CH 1. SC in CH space. CH 3. SC in CH space. Turn.

Row 4: CH 4. 3 DC in CH space. CH 1. DC in last stitch. Turn.

Row 5: CH 1. SC in CH space. CH 3. SC in space. Turn.

Row 6: CH 4. DC in first stitch. CH 4. 3 DC in along DC in space. CH 1. (This increases the "squares" along this row.) *(3 DC in space, CH 1) across. DC in last stitch. Turn.

Row 7: CH 1. SC in space, *(CH 3, SC in next space) across. Turn,

Row 8: CH 4. *(3 DC in space, CH 1) across. DC in last stitch. Turn.

Row 9: CH 1. SC in space. *(CH 3, SC in net space) across. Turn.

Repeat rows 6 - 9 until straight edge of shawl is about 30 inches wide. END ON ROW 8.

Decrease rows:

Row A: CH 1. SC in space. *(CH 3, SC in the next space) across, ending with a SC right before the last set of 3 DC and omitting the last CH 3 and SC. Turn.

Row B: CH 4. *(3 DC in space, CH 1) across. DC in last stitch. Turn.

Row C: CH 1. SC in space. *(CH 3, SC in next space.) across. Turn.

Row D: CH 4. *(3 DC in space, CH 1) across. DC in last stitch. Turn.

Repeat row A-D until you are down to 1 block of 3 DC.

Row E: CH 1. SC in space. CH 3, SC in last space. Fasten off and weave in ends.
