INSTRUCTIONS – HEART PILLOW (for mastectomy patients)

<u>Use</u>: Under the arm or across the chest under a seatbelt.

Materials

Pattern – see attached (print at 100%)
Fabric – soft cotton or flannel. 1/2 yard, 44" wide will make at least one pillow.
Stuffing



Instructions

- 1. The small triangle in the middle of pattern needs to be cut out separately and attached to bottom of the pattern. You may want to make a stiffer pattern from cardboard.
- 2. Place the pattern edge on the fold as noted. Cut 2 for front and back.
- 3. With right sides together, sew 1/4" seam around leaving about 3" to 4" opening on one side.
- 4. Clip curved seams. Turn.
- 5. Stuff so the pillow is "soft and squishy."
- 6. Sew up the opening, either by hand, or by machine with a <u>very</u> small seam (no larger than 1/8").
