The American Legion of Greer is spearheading Wreaths across America for Greer, which involves getting donations for purchasing the wreaths and volunteers to place the wreaths at the veterans' graves.



How to get involved:

- Volunteer: We need volunteers to help lay wreaths on December 13th.

What does sponsoring a wreath mean? It's a personal gift of gratitude and remembrance for a veteran who served our country, supporting the year-long mission to remember the fallen, honor those who serve, and teach the next generation the value of freedom.
