




### **New Google Workspace Live – Website Coming Soon!**


But that's not all! We're also working on a new club website, designed to be a go-to resource for members and visitors alike.

# **District 7750 Foundation Dinner Highlights Local and Global Impact**

The recent **Rotary Foundation Training and Dinner** in Greenville showcased the incredible work being done worldwide through the Foundation—and how it directly benefits us here at home.



One of the key takeaways? Roughly half of every dollar donated to the Rotary Foundation returns to our district as **District Designated Funds**. District designated funds may be used for grants to fund impactful projects globally, and right here in the Upstate, and thanks to our club's contributions, we'll be **eligible to apply for matching grants starting in the spring of 2025!** The amount we can request as a grant is directly tied to our overall contributions to the Foundation, as well as the funds we have as a club to support the project.

While our grant eligibility depends on overall giving, achieving **EREY (Every Rotarian Every Year)** status is an exciting goal that reflects our collective commitment to service. We're encouraging every club member to contribute **\$25 or more** this year to help us earn this recognition—it would be a feather in our cap and a testament to our dedication to Rotary's mission.
