SECRETARY'S REPORT

Motion was made to approve the December meeting minutes by Donna Mosteller and seconded by Connie Holovics.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Donna Mosteller submitted a treasurer's report. Income for the month of December was \$6,321. Expenses for the month of December was \$1,791. The balance for the end of December was \$5,914. Insurance payments for the month of January, April and July of 2017 were discussed. Motion made to accept by Connie and seconded by Thomas Amodeo.
