
WRCA Board Meeting

March 8th, 2016

The March meeting of the WRCA was called to order at 7:35 pm. by Board Member Tom Amodeo. In attendance were Treasurer Donna Mosteller, Secretary Marijean Nichols and Board Members Connie Holovics, John Radens, Andy Annesi and Erich Krueger.

President Jim Cwierley was recently asked to be on the Town of Amherst Planning Board. Since Amherst's meeting was at the same date/time as the WRCA Board meeting, Tom assumed the President's duties for this meeting The minutes from the January meeting were approved. There were no official February minutes as we did not have the necessary quorum needed to conduct any official business.

The new Treasurer. Donna Mosteller, will present the Treasurer's Report at the next meeting. Donna has been working with Tom Amodeo, previous treasurer, on a smooth transition and double-checking to be sure that all WRCA financial records are in order. Tom presented the January and February reports.



Treasurer' Report: Income for the month of January was \$119. Expenses were \$1073. The balance for the month of January was \$2500.

Income for the month of February was \$952. Expenses were \$74. The balance for the month of February was \$3378. The reports for January and February were approved.

Membership Report: Nine new members joined since January. Connie and Jane Sieman have been working to correct all the errors that have not been updated in the past several yearly directories. The new directory for 2016 should reflect the corrected information.

President's Report (presented by Tom in Jim's absence to attend the Town of Amherst's meeting): A motion to amend the WRCA constitution and by-laws to reduce the WRCA Board from ten members to nine members, was made and seconded at the January 2016 meeting. After much discussion, the motion was tabled to allow community comments before a vote can be taken, per the existing rules of order. The tabled motion was published in the February *WITW*. As there was no opposition from the community on the motion, the motion was reintroduced and a vote was taken and approved unanimously.

There were twenty homes that were judged to be winners in the Holiday lighting contest. Only five of these residences were members of the WRCA, membership in the association is required to be considered to win. These five winning homes will be announced in the *WITW* and each winner will receive a \$10 gift certificate donated by Valu Home Center. The five remaining donated gift cards will be saved for future use.
