Snowflake Thank You's



WRCA Minutes March 13, 2012

President Ed Goetz called the meeting to order at 7:35 p.m. Also present were Vice President Karen Tyno, Treasurer Rick VonLangen, and Secretary Dawn Cwierley. Board members present were Jim Cwierley, Debbie Goetz, Connie Holovics and Bill VanSplunder. Also in attendance was Lynn Getzin, membership chair.

Secretary Minutes: Minutes were approved with one change, noting that Bill VanSplunder's name was incorrectly listed as James VanSplunder. A motion was made by Rick VonLangen to approve the secretary minutes from the February meeting. Connie Holovics seconded and board approval followed.

Treasurer Report: Rick VonLangen reported that there is currently an account balance of \$12,405. Jim Cwierley made a motion to approve, seconded by Connie Holovics and board approval was granted.

President's Report: Ed Goetz gave details of Amherst Board meeting that addressed the wait at the Willow Ridge/ Niagara Falls Boulevard traffic signal. It was noted that this is Department of Transportation issue, which they will evaluate and address. No changes will be made to the light at this time. It was also reported that Ed had received a thank you note from the Girl Scouts regarding the Civic Association's recent donation.

Old Business: Ed Goetz reported that he spoke with Bob Foladare regarding the WRCA Scholarships. The board discussed details about the scholarship fund and how monies will be distributed. This year \$2,000 is available. The board decided that the monies would be distributed between four students, two females and two males.

Mark Hammer, Sweet Home Schools liaison was absent and unable to report on budget.

New Business: Kristen Cioppa, president of the WRCA Playground Committee, spoke regarding the status of the playground. To date, \$7,000 has bee raised and some grants received to help with costs. The committee is targeting May for installation, for which volunteers will be needed. The committee will be selling Anderson coupon books and
