WRCA Minutes June 12, 2012

President Ed Goetz called the meeting to order at 7:35 p.m. Also present were Treasurer Rick VonLangen and Secretary Dawn Cwierley. Board members present were Jim Cwierley, Mark Hammer, Debbie Goetz, Bill VanSplunder, Mark Hammer and Carol Zaffram. Also in attendance were Lynn Getzin, membership chair and James Newbert.

Secretary Minutes: Minutes were approved and a motion was made by Mark Hammer to approve the secretary minutes from the March meeting. Carol Zaffram seconded and board approval followed.

Treasurer Report: Rick VonLangen reported that there is currently \$8908 in the bank. Bills for the Snow Flake Dance have been finalized. It was noted that \$2,000 would be given to students as part of the scholarship program. The board decided that a check for that total would be sent directly to Dollars for Scholars. Debbie Goetz made a motion to approve, seconded by Mark Hammer and board approval was granted.

President's Report: Ed Goetz shared that there were 30 participants in this year's neighborhood garage sale. Last year there were 50 participants. Committee discussed the idea of adding Thursday back into the schedule. The committee reviewed the 2012-2013 budget against the 2011-2012 budget. Jim Cwierley made a motion to approve, seconded by Carl Zaffram and board approval was granted. It was reported that efforts to secure a location have not been successful.

New Business: John Miller reported plans for the 2012 National Night Out. It was suggested that each family complete a registration card that would both assist in an accurate participant count and give each family a chance to win prizes. Ed Goetz will reach out to someone to see what can be done. 723 Edgewater appears to have renters event though it is not zoned for this. This will be forwarded to the building inspector for review.




