Secretary's Minutes:

A motion was made by Bob Foladare to approve the secretary minutes from the February meeting, Karen Tyno seconded, board approval followed.

Treasurers Report:

Rick VonLangen reports \$2024.00 income for February, with expenses of \$1360.00 and an ending account balance of \$16,041.00. John Valkwitch made a motion to approve, seconded by Karen Tyno board approval was unanimous.

Presidents Report:

No correspondence received by President Ed Goetz.

<u>Membership Report:</u> The number of WRCA 2011 renewals was 649 received as of 3/8/11.

Old Business:


