January 12, 2010

President Bob Foladare called the meeting to order at 7:35pm. Excused were Jack Baker and Karen Tyno. Community attendees included Cam Hill and Neil Cuomo, Carol Zaffram, Kathy Land, Debbie Goetz, Debby VonLangen, Jim Prentice, Julie Goetz, Vince Hanley, John Safford, Rob Bertone, and N.A. Hammoud. A motion was made by Ed Goetz to approve the secretary minutes from the November meeting, John Radens seconded and a board approval followed.

#### **Treasurer's Report**

Ed Goetz reported for Jack Baker that all expenses were met from December. Expenses were \$746.00; income was \$582.00 with an account balance of \$11,732.00. A motion was made by Pat Land and seconded by Joe Battaglia to approve the treasurer's report; board approval was unanimous.

#### **President's Report**




