#### Dear Friends and Neighbors,



**February 10, 2009**

The secretary's minutes from January were reviewed and a motion was made by Jim Prentice and seconded by Ed Goetz to approve said minutes. A board approval followed.

### Treasurer's Report

Treasurer Jack Baker reported that all expenses were met from January. Jack noted that income from ad sales and membership dues continue to come in. A check for \$1000.00 will be sent to Sweet Home Dollars for Scholars, for the WRCA sponsored scholarships. A motion was made by Joe Battaglia and seconded by Jim Prentice to approve the treasurer's report; board approval was unanimous.

### President's Report

Amherst Supervisor Satish Mohan and a Town of Amherst engineer will attend our next meeting, to answer residents' questions and talk about future town plans.

President Foladare also reported that it has been brought to his attention that a business was advertised in the classified section of the *Wind-in-the-Willows*. The board restated the policy that this section of our monthly newsletter is provided free of charge to association members as a service to sell personal or household items and not to advertise a business. ### Membership Report

Membership Director Kerri Jasen stated that 610 paid renewals have been received. This number represents 75% of last year's membership, with the membership drive still ongoing.
