WRCA Meeting Minutes February 13, 2007

The meeting was called to order by Bob Folandare at 7:41 pm. In attendance were President Jim Prentice, Vice President Bob Folandare, Secretary Clayton Cobb, Treasurer Ed Goetz, and Board Members Cam Hill (past president), Pat Land, Bill Pujolas, Joe Battaglia. Also attending were Kerri Jason, and Neil Cuomo. Joining the meeting was Girl Scout Troop 1792 to observe the proceedings.

SECRETARY’S MINUTES

The minutes from the January meeting were reviewed. A motion was made by Bob Folandare, seconded by Kerri Jason to approve the minutes, which was carried.

TREASURER’S REPORT

The treasurer’s report was brought forth by acting treasurer, Ed Goetz. He reported that membership income in February was \$330.00 and that current membership enrollment was now at pace with last year’s sign up. He also reported all February expenses including directory printing and including newsletter postage through March had been paid. Kerri Jason made a motion to approve the report, seconded by Pat Land, which was carried.

PRESIDENT’S REPORT/CORRESPONDENCE

WRCA’s President Jim Prentice brought up as a point of discussion to review the process that residents should use to have news entered into the newsletter. He stated that many times there is information about resident families that may not be published in the newsletter. From the discussion came the decision to let residents know they should contact their block head reporter with information they might want published.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Membership(Kerri Jason)

Kerri reported that 330 entered into WRCA membership. She also reported that the Rep Breakfast was a huge success with 50 people in attendance. The Erie County Water Authority offered a presentation and Bob Folandare answered many questions for the group. Kerri also announced that directories and rosters are out to the block reps.

Garage Sale (Helene Motyka)

The WRCA garage sale will be held May 17—19. The WRCA Board has approved all funds needed to make it a success and

hopes everyone will be involved.

Junior Recreation

President Jim Prentice reported that a junior recreation leader has been found but not yet named as a matter of record.

OLD BUSINESS

Bob Folandare and Cam Hill attended the meeting with American Campus as reported in a recent newsletter. The outcome was a letter received by WRCA outlining the requests and a response to each request. The letter can be reviewed by residents on the WRCA website. Cam Hill and Pat Land will meet with the Condo Association on February 15 to discuss any further neighborhood response. Thank you to Bob and Cam for their continued effort in this matter.

In a follow up to the information that was given regarding the repaving of Willow Ridge after the sewer renovations, the town will repave Willow Ridge during the spring or summer. No firm dates have been given, but Neil Cuomo reported that the repaving was in the budget for the project. Lawn restoration will also take place during the same periods. Mr. Cuomo will send a letter to the town to confirm their intent on repaving.

NEW BUSINESS

WRCA is proud to announce their project to upgrade the ball diamonds at Willow Ridge school has been heartily welcomed and approved by the school district. A letter was received from School Superintendent Geoffrey Hicks thanking the WRCA for the plans, funds and manpower for the project. Mr. Hicks also offered equipment and tech support for the project. The WRCA will be renovating the diamonds in the spring so all residents can take advantage of the upgrade. David Lovering, Willow Ridge principal, Ken Koch, supervisor of buildings and grounds, and Chris Demarco, director of HPEA also gave blessing to the project.

Bob Folandare and Joe Battaglia will attend an Association of Taxpayers meeting on February 28 at town hall. Details of the meeting are not yet known but a report will be given by them at the next WRCA meeting followed by an overview in the next newsletter.

No further business being at hand, a motion was made by Bob Folandare, seconded by Ed Goetz to adjourn at 8:30 p.m., which was carried.




