

WRCA MINUTES FOR TUESDAY, JUNE 12, 2018

The June WRCA meeting was called to order at 7:35 pm by President Erich Krueger.

Excused were Treasurer. Donna Mosteller and Board Member Kristen Puff. Also in attendance were Amherst Police Capt. Kevin Brown, Kelly Sieman, William & Patty Lisk, Dennis & Susan Mulvey, Richard Cusack, Gary Aquilina, David Stewart, Earl & Heidi Kunz, Evelyn Hitchcock, and James & Jane Steel.

Amherst Police Captain Kevin Brown was guest tonight. Capt. Brown listened to concerns from the Willow Ridge residents. One of the discussions was in regards to the police enforcement in Willow Ridge from May 30, to June 7th where 42 tickets were written for speeding and going thru stop signs. Among areas of concerns that were discussed, were Kaymar Dr (speed and

drivers ignoring stop signs), school zones speed and lack of school zone signs. Capt. Brown also discussed the Amherst Police Department's priorities and resources. President Erich Krueger and available board members will be attending the next Town of Amherst Board meeting to propose getting School Zone/speed signs on Willow Green and Willow Ridge Dr. Residents were encouraged to attend as well.
