



Sidewalk Repairs

s some of you have noticed, the town has been marking sidewalks in need of repair.

Much of the damage to our sidewalks is due from the town's trees. I have reached out to the Town of Amherst (Highway Dept. and Building Dept.) regarding damaging tree roots. I will give you the answers I received.

According to Patrick Lucey, Superintendent of Highways, "If the sidewalk is removed where the Town tree roots exist, the Highway Department will go out and grind the roots. We need access to the roots in order to grind them out."

Furthermore, the answer I got from the Code Enforcer of the Building Department is more detailed.

NOTES regarding sidewalk repair when a town tree is involved:

The following information has been provided by the Town of Amherst Highway Superintendent regarding root grinding when sidewalks are scheduled to be replaced:

- Tree roots must be cut out or ground when repairing sidewalk sections. By no means should the roots be removed by a backhoe or similar machine.
- 2. The root removal is the responsibility of the homeowner when replacing sidewalks. The resident must contact Underground Facilities Protection (UFPO 1-800-962-7962) before they dig.
- If a large root is involved, please call the Highway Department at 631-7117 for safety concerns. A crew chief will check out these concerns.

Perhaps this is related to the hack of Facebook. The email address where I am suddenly receiving these suspicious emails is the address I provided Facebook when setting up that account. ~ **Good Luck** ~


