

The Town of Amherst Police Department and Town of Amherst Supervisor have partnered to create the "We are Amherst" campaign, a NYS Police Reform and Reinvention Collaborative. The mission of "We Are Amherst" is to proactively review, evaluate, modify, and modernize the Town of Amherst's current policing policies, procedures, and practices to better address the needs of its citizens and stakeholders, and to improve and promote public safety, community engagement and trust.

The Town of Amherst, along with its police department, will work with the community to create and recommend a plan which better addresses the needs of the citizens and stakeholders of the Town of Amherst. Implementation of this plan is to promote fair and just policing, enhance community relations and engagement, and to foster trust and mutual cooperation.

We would like to invite you to participate as a Stakeholder Group member for the Homeowners Association community group. Your primary function as a group member would be to attend a virtual meeting to discuss issues and topics which affect your network, community members, and past, present, and future experiences with the Amherst Police. Also, we'll ask you to deliver feedback and concerns from individuals and groups within your network back to our community facilitators. This will involve talking with your own organization and other organizations within your networks/communities to gain their perspectives and input. Some of the key focuses that we will work through include:

- Review and evaluation of current police policies, procedures, and practices.
- Open discussion on plan development to improve such policies, procedures, and practices.

The responses we gather through our Stakeholder Groups will help the Town address past and present issues and concerns, and help to drive reform and reinvention policy changes.

We plan to coordinate a meeting with all of the interested members of this group to further explain details and to address any questions you may have.
