In order to manage your eczema or your child's eczema you should follow all of the selected recommendations below:	
ACTION: MAINTAIN AND PROTECT SKIN	
Apply	(non-soap based body wash or oil) moisturiser after bath/shower
ACTION: TREAT FLARE

Bleach baths 1, 2 or 3 times/week:  mls unscented domestic bleach (~4 - 4.5%)/ ml water OR  mls unscented domestic bleach in full, or 1/2 bath  Additional instructions:  Rinse and immediately apply moisturiser after bleach bath  Nasal ointments: 1, 2 times/day  Treatment oral antibiotic: Dose: 1, 2 mg tablet or ml; times/day  for a total of days  Oral antibiotic prophylaxis: Dose: mg tablet or ml; times/day  Varicella vaccination Additional instructions: mg tablet or ml; times/day
