

THROW LINE IS 21 FEET FROM FRONT EDGE OF OVER/UNDER BOARD.


IF PLAYING WITH 2 BOARDS, 21 FEET FRONT EDGE TO FRONT EDGE

LANYARD ASSESSING IN PLAY




A PLAYER WITH THEIR BALL(S) FURTHEST FROM THE BOARD & OUTSIDE OF THE SAFE ZONE (BALLS THAT COME TO REST SHORT OF THE BOARD AND OUTSIDE THE LENGTH OF THE LANYARD) GET A 1 POINT DEDUCTION FOR EACH BALL FURTHER AWAY FROM THE IW DISC THAN THEIR OPPONENTS BALL. NOTE: ONLY 1 PLAYER CAN LOSE POINT(S) PER ROUND & CANNOT LOSE MORE POINTS THAN THEY HAVE.

HOW TO PLAY ONTOP OVER/UNDER

- PLAYERS HAVE 3 BALLS EACH & ALTERNATE TOSSES FROM 21 FEET AWAY UNTIL ALL BALLS HAVE BEEN TOSSED
- POINTS ARE AWARDED AS DEFINED ABOVE. POINTS CAN BE EARNED BY LANDING ON THE BOARD OR BEING CLOSEST TO THE IW DISC BEYOND THE BOARD. CANCELLATION POINTS APPLY TO ONLY BALLS ON THE SURFACE OF THE BOARD (points earned for closest to the IW disc beyond the board cannot be cancelled by on board balls).
- THE PLAYER SCORING THE GREATER NUMBER OF POINTS DURING THE ROUND TOSSES FIRST THE NEXT ROUND.
- THE LANYARD CAN BE USED TO DETERMINE ELIGIBLE POINTS AS WELL AS WHETHER A BALL IS COMPLETELY IN-PLAY.
- THE MATCH IS PLAYED TO 15 & A PLAYER CANNOT WIN BY GETTING A POINT DEDUCTION ON THEIR FINAL TOSS.


IF A PLAYER GOES OVER 15, IT IS CALLED A "SCREAMER" (BUST). You subtract the number of points over 15 from your point total before the round. For example, if you had 13 heading into the round, and you scored 4 points in the round, it would put you at 17 points (2 points over 15), which would be a SCREAMER. Therefore, your new score would be 11 (13-2).

THE ONTOP OVER/UNDER "BOARD" GAME




Gray Ball: 0 POINTS (BALL ON BOARD IS CANCELLED BY WHITE BALL, BALL BEYOND BOARD IS FURTHER THAN WHITE, ONE GRAY BALL OUT OF PLAY)

White Ball: 2 POINTS (BALL IN HOLE WORTH 3 BUT 2 POINTS ARE CANCELLED BY GRAY BALL ON BOARD, BALL BEYOND BOARD IS CLOSEST TO IW DISC THAN GRAY & THEREFORE WORTH 1 POINT)



Gray Ball: 4 POINTS (BALL ON BOARD IS WORTH 5 POINTS, BALL SHORT OF THE BOARD IS FURTHER THAN WHITE & OUTSIDE LANYARD, SO 1 POINT IS DEDUCTED)

White Ball: 1 POINT (BALL OVER BOARD IS JUST WITHIN THE LANYARD, THE BALL LEFT OF THE BOARD IS OUT OF PLAY & BALL SHORT OF THE BOARD IS CLOSER THAN A GRAY BALL SO NO POINTS ARE DEDUCTED.



Gray Ball : 2 POINTS (BALL ON BOARD IS CANCELLED BY WHITE, BOTH BALLS BEYOND BOARD ARE CLOSER THAN WHITE, FOR 1 POINT EACH). NOTE: THE GRAY BALL IN CENTER LOGO IS NOT WORTH 5 POINTS BECAUSE THE PERIMETER OF THE LOGO IS NOT COMPLETELY VISIBLE.

White Ball: 2 POINTS (BALLS ON BOARD ARE WORTH 2 POINTS EACH, BUT GRAY CANCELS 2 POINTS, & BALL BEYOND BOARD IS FURTHER FROM IW DISC THAN THE CLOSEST GRAY BALL.



Gray Ball: 3 POINTS (BALL ON BOARD IS WORTH 3 POINTS, BALLS OVER BOARD ARE FURTHER AWAY FROM THE IW DISC THAN THE CLOSEST WHITE BALL AND THEREFORE ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR POINTS)

White Ball: 1 POINT (BALL OVER BOARD IS CLOSEST TO THE IW DISC THAN THE GRAY BALLS & THE BALL UNDER (SHORT OF) THE BOARD IS JUST IN THE SAFE ZONE [WITHIN THE LENGTH OF THE LANYARD] SO NO POINTS ARE DEDUCTED.

Important Note:

Your OVER/UNDER game boards are made of MDF & finished with an exterior paint. With MDF, it is important to keep them away from moisture & store in a relatively dry space to prolong the life of the boards. If not, your boards will degrade & warp, considerably shortening the life of the boards.

Degree of Difficulty, based on both versions of balls:

 Juggling Style Balls vs. Hacky Sack: The Juggling style balls are fuller than the hacky sack style balls and therefore more challenging to score points on the board surface as well as control the direction of the ball.
