Food for Thought

Your value in God's eyes is not tied to being married, dating, or wanted by someone romantically. You were called “very good” in Genesis 1:31 long before the first wedding took place. God’s love isn’t waiting on your relationship status, it’s here now.

Singleness is sacred because identity is sacred. When we treat singleness as something to escape rather than steward, we miss the gift God is giving, a season to grow roots in Him, boundaries in life, and confidence in His unchanging love.
