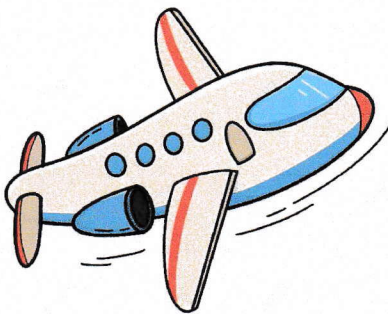
### FALL CONFERENCE 2025

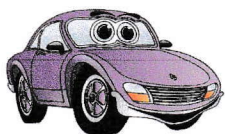
