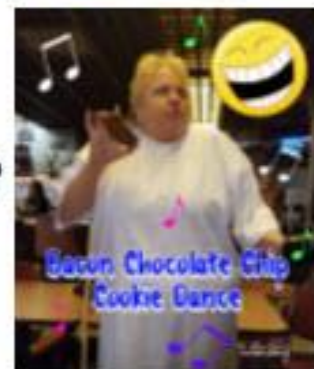
In the meantime, enjoy the spring whenever it happens. Congrats to all you sisters for bringing in new and reenrolled members.
