MOTEL ACCOMODATIONS

The Red Lion Hotel Yakima Center (Aerie and Auxiliary Headquarters) Phone (509) 248-5900 has Eagle's contracted room rates of \$109.00 per night for 1 or 2 people, \$119.00 per night for 3 people, or \$129.00 per night for 4 people. The room rate includes a daily breakfast for up to the total number of

9840. We have a block of rooms under contract with contract pricing available at the Red Lion Hotel only. You can contact the Red Lion directly at (509) 248-5900 and get the same price if you let them know you are with the Eagles but your reservation will only provide a room not a room location. **Again, these contract prices do not include taxes.** Or you can reach the Holiday Inn Express Yakima at phone (509) 249-1000, the Holiday Inn Downtown Yakima (across from the Convention center) at (509) 4947000, or the Fairfield Inn & Suites, at (509) 452-3100. These locations do not have contract pricing. Each Aerie or Auxiliary and individual is responsible for making his or her own reservations. **If you have a person with a wheelchair, please let the Red Lion know so they do not get put on the second floor.** If no first-floor rooms are available, you may need to use another hotel.
