# **CONTEST RULES FOR TALENT SCHOLARSHIP CONTEST**

## **August 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2025**

1. The contestant must be sponsored by an Aerie, Auxiliary, Past Presidents Club or an Eagle in Good Standing.
2. They will be judged on poise, appearance, in casual and formal attire.
3. They must present talent of their choice not to exceed five minutes. They must perform solo except they can use a CD, cassette tape, or an instrumental accompaniment.
4. They must give a two minute impromptu speech, the topic will be drawn from a hat.
5. The Aerie that is hosting the FunVention will select the judges.
6. Winners have 12 months to claim their scholarships or the money goes back into the fund for the following contests.
7. Contestants must be between the ages of 16-22 years of age and at least a senior in High School, during the current high school year.
8. No scholarship awards will be made to contestants unless they present evidence to the Past Presidents Association that they have entered into school or proof that the student is already enrolled and has already paid their tuition, in this case the money may go to the winners.
9. All money received for this program will be used for the same or ear marked for the next year's program
10. Contestants must be registered by August 20<sup>th</sup> on an application form along with the entry fee.
11. Contestants must be at the meeting Friday Night before the contest for the drawing of order of appearance, interview and instructions for the contest.
12. Contestant's Parents are responsible for the cost of their own meals
13. Sponsoring Aerie/Aux is responsible for informing contestants that they need money for toll cost and other needed expenses.
