



WASHINGTON STATE EAGLES YOUTH CONVENTION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM



RULES AND REQUIREMENTS

- Section 1 There will be one or more scholarships awarded per year. The number of Scholarships to be presented to be determined by funds that are available and applications received. The number of scholarships, placement and amounts to be given out will be determined by the Board of Administrators.
- Section 2 To be eligible individual must have participated in the previous (consecutive) Washington State Eagles Youth Convention and be registering as a participant in Convention the year the application is being submitted.
- Section 3 Individual must be graduating or have previously graduated the year of application or have a GED or equivalent degree by the date the application is due. Maximum age to apply is twenty (20) years of age.
- Section 4 This scholarship will be awarded based on academic merit, participation in your community and school activities.
- Section 5 The Scholarship Funds are to be used at an accredited College or an accredited Trade School.
- Section 6 Application must be received or must be postmarked on or before the third Saturday in May when the Washington State Youth Committee meets. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS REQUIREMENT. The Committee will not be responsible for an application not received by the deadline and late applications will not be accepted for consideration.
- Section 7 The following items must be submitted for review by the Scholarship Committee/Board of Administrators.
- A Complete Scholarship Application Form
 - a. Application must be typed/or computer written. **Applications will be disqualified if they are hand written.**
Essays must be 1000 to 1500 words, typed. Heading not included in number count.
 - b. Do not attach any documents or additional pages to the application, except as required
 - c. Review the entire application before filling it out. If a field is left blank, it may result in the application being disqualified. If you cannot answer a question include a reason in the field.
 - d. Proofread/Review the application and answers before submitting it. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
 - e. Keep a copy of everything that you submit.
 - B. Complete the essay questions and submit with the application.
 - a. Each application is judged on its own merit.
 - C. Two reference letters are required:
 - a. One from a Fraternal Order of Eagles Member in good standing.
 - b. One from a professional adult (Teacher, Minister, Employer or other)
 - D. A copy of the acceptance letter from the school you will be attending.
 - E. A personal interview will be conducted.
 - a. You will receive notification of time and date one week prior to interview.
 - b. The Interview panel will be appointed by the Washington State Youth Committee and consist of no less than three and no more than five individuals.
- Section 8 Individuals will not be eligible for more than one scholarship award from this Washington State Eagles Youth Scholarship Program.
- Section 9 Check will be made out to the school in the name of the scholarship winner and must be used within the current school year/prior to the next year's convention.
- Section 10 Winners have 12 months to claim their scholarships or the money goes back into the fund for the following Scholarship Awards program.
- Section 11 Scholarships will be announced at the Washington State Youth Convention held in June each year.



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Eligibility: The applicant must have participated in the previous, Washington State Eagles Youth Conventions. The applicant must be graduating or have previously graduated the year he/she is applying for the Washington State Eagles Youth Scholarship or have a GED or equivalent degree by the date the scholarship is awarded. The maximum age limit shall be through twenty (20) years. See Rules and Requirements for Scholarship complete information. Application must be typed or computer generated. Applications will be returned if they are handwritten.

 - B. Describe the school and any community activities that you participate in.
 - C. Describe activities that would provide examples of your leadership skills/ability.
 - D. What College or Trade institute do you plan to attend and why? What career path do you plan on pursuing and why?
 - E. Describe any accomplishments that you wish to emphasize that are not included in the above questions.
