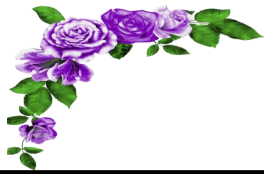
In closing, remember to check on the elderly and those that are shut in. Plus be kind to one another. As we are People Helping People Hand and Hand.

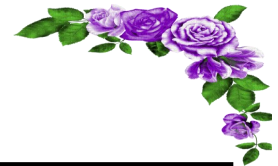
