JUMP RIGHT IN – THE WATER IS WARM

- Do you want to be a Washington State Officer? This is a question that each member needs to ask themselves. If the answer is yes. First, one must go through the chairs of your local Aerie. It took myself six years, as there was an outside guard at that time. I went through all the local chairs, and when June came, I ran for state office. I started the first of the year while I was still president. The only requirement was I had to be a past president by the first of June. Now that means you have had to have been president at your local Aerie. You could start out as the local president, but I would not recommend that. There is a lot of things to learn along the way and stepping right in is not so good in my opinion. The only other way is a ten-year secretary.

This is how my adventure started. I had been duped into taking a local chair. As the outside guard at Wenatchee #204, I ran two raffles at the door, so I started early making money for charity. The outside guard asks for your membership card outside the meeting room. This way he or she gets to know the people that attend the meetings. Each chair teaches a little more about the ritual. So, when you run for state office you should know how the meetings are ran, and a general understanding of what the Eagles are all about. Most of the stuff you will alone take to State Convention. Big brothers have theirs as well so what they tell you is slanted in their favor. Take what you have learned and go with it. Do your best to be a good Eagle. There are no kings in the Eagles. We are all the same. In this way you will add to Eagledom in a good way. But this is only my opinion. You do now and will have your own in the future.

I had been going to State Eagle events for about two years and was the local Conductor. Bill Walton had talked Bobby into going on a river raft run up the Snake River. Twenty years earlier I had been secretary of the Junior Chamber of Commerce of East Wenatchee. At that time people drank more and really had a good time. The example I am going to use is the time all the brothers of the Junior Chamber went on a Rubber Raft Race down the Snake River. The race was about seven miles long. There was a power boat that would throw cases of beer in the rafts, as we were to drink as much as we could while racing down the river. There were many rapids on the way down. So, Bobby just had to go on the yearly raft trip up the Snake River that Ed Berry had started years before. The State Eagle Presidents always went on that boat trip up the river. I met Lady Diana, Kay Berquist and Dennis Allen. I liked them so much that I let them talk myself into running for state office. All I had to do was go through the chairs at Wenatchee #204. So, I did, and so can you.

William "Bill" Stotko Grand Aerie Outside Guard

Bill Stotko, Grand Worthy Inside Guard, joined the Fraternal Order of Eagles in September of 1977, joining the Monroe Eagles #2327 in Monroe Washington. He quickly became involved in the Fraternal side of the Fraternal order of Eagles, working his way through the Officer chairs of his home Aerie. Although Brother Bill was a Truck Driver by trade, he could always be depended on to step up when assistance was needed in maintaining his home Aerie.

Brother Bill became President of Monroe Aerie in 1997 – 1998 after working his way up through the chairs. Brother Bill has also held the position of Aerie President. Bill eventually had to transfer to Everett Aerie 13, in Everett Washington, following the closure of his home Aerie. Since his transfer to Everett Aerie #13, Brother Bill has the positions of Aerie President and Aerie Trustee as well as the Aerie Secretary. Brother Bill has held the position of Aerie Secretary, for 7 Eagles years in both the Monroe Eagles as well as the Everett Eagles. Currently, Brother Bill is once again filling the position of Aerie Secretary.

Brother Bill became the Washington State Aerie President during the 2010 – 2011 Eagle year after working his way up through the chairs beginning his journey at the Trustee level in 2001 - 2002. During this period, Brother Bill was also very involved in the initial development of the Washington State Aerie training program, being a part of the original group that put the training program together. Much of the training program was later adopted by the Grand Aerie in the development of the Grand Aerie Training program.

Brother Bill was selected from among all the Past State Presidents of Washington State to be the Pacific Northwest Reginal President for the Eagle year 2018 – 2019.

During this same period of time, Brother Bill has also been very active in working with Aeries in difficulty throughout the United States. Brother Bill's knowledge of the Grand Aerie Statutes as well as his respect for members rights, has given him the ability, working with these distressed Eagle Aeries and Auxiliaries, to bring them back into full compliance with our order.

Brother Bill has filled the position of Grand Aerie Elections Chairman for the last several years, being instrument in converting the election counting process into an electronic process that is able to tabulate the election count and provide results in hours rather than the days that it used to take. This same process was later adopted by the Grand Auxiliary as well.

Brother Bill and his wife Carey have been married for 33 years and have three children, Philip, Patricia, and Theresa. Additionally, Brother Bill and Sister Carey have seven Grand Children.


