Definitions



Police Use of Force:

"The amount of effort required by police to compel compliance by an unwilling subject"-IACA

BPD Policy (threshold for writing a report):

Any action other than compliant hand-cuffing that an officer is required to use to:

- 1) arrest an individual suspected of committing a crime
- 2) temporarily detain an individual to complete an investigation
- 3) address an immediate threat to the safety of the public , law enforcement officers, or the person of interest

as a result of non-compliance

In determining whether a particular response to resistance (use of force option) is objectively reasonable the officer must consider;

- 1) the seriousness of the offense the officer suspects when the force option is employed;
- 2) whether or not the subject poses an immediate physical threat to the officer or others and the degree of that threat
- 3) whether the subject is actively resisting or attempting to evade arrest by flight;
- 4) whether the totality of the circumstances justify the officer's response

Definitions (analytical)



Term	Definition
Use of Force Event	Use of force occurrence in a single time and location which could include multiple officers and suspects (determined by unique "Incident Number")
Use of Force Interaction	Any unique suspect vs officer contact involving an officer use of force. Multiple Use of Force Interactions can make up a single Use of Force Event.
Use of Force Iteration	Any individual action an officer takes against a suspect within a unique Use of Force Incident
Suspect Resistance Iteration	Any individual act of resistance a suspect takes against an officer within a unique Use of Force Incident

This means:

- 1.2 suspects per event
- 1.7 unique police-suspect interactions per event
- 3.5 iterations of force per suspect




UOF Events by Year Compared to Police Contacts and Arrests




Most Severe Force Used in Interactions Involving an Arrest (n=15,423)


Force Types Used in UOF Interactions Compared to Most Severe Force Type Used Per Interaction

Most Severe Police Force Type Used Per Unique Interaction by Year (n=2819)







BPD Arrest Population










Analysis: Injuries by Race

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



Odds Ratio for Suspect Injury (Controls)



Most Severe Force Type Used in Interactions by Suspect Race





Odds Ratio for Most Severe Force Type (Controls)



Only force types which differ across race groups to a statistically significant degree shown here (4).







Odds Ratio for Indiv. Force Type (baseline)




Odds Ratio for Indiv. Force Type (Controls)





Equal Response:Resistance

More severe resistance than response



Main Findings



- 1) UOF incidents make up small percentage of police activity (1% of police contacts; 11% of arrests)
- 2) As arrests and calls for service have increased, UOF incidents have decreased (33 fewer UOF events per year)
- 3) In 2016, UOF incidents were comprised of a higher percentage of weaponless tactics and a lower percentage of weapon threats than from 2010-2015
- 4) People of Color are overrepresented by 10% (2 percentage points) in the pool of UOF suspects as compared to their make-up of Burlington arrest suspects
 - Black individuals specifically are overrepresented by 13% (2 percentage points)
- 5) The disparity between White and People of Color suspects in odds of having a gun pointed at them is statistically significant (People of Color 37% higher odds)
- 6) No major differences across race groupings in terms of average police force:suspect resistance ratio
