

After a Rocky Start....Miami Road Construction Begins

Dear Harbordale Neighbors,

We want to keep you informed about the construction activity in your neighborhood as part of the City of Fort Lauderdale's ongoing infrastructure improvement program.

What's Happening:

Construction for the new wastewater force main is underway in the Harbordale neighborhood. The first phase of work includes:

- Open cut sewer installation along SE 15th Street between SE 10th Avenue and Miami Road
- Trenchless sewer installation along Miami Road

- Sewer rehabilitation along SE 10th Avenue between SE 15th Street and SE 17th Street

This work is scheduled to take place during the summer (June through August) to minimize impacts on Harbordale Elementary School and the surrounding area.

Traffic & Access:

Temporary detours and lane closures are in place as needed.

Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) plans were developed to ensure the safety of residents, students, and workers, while maintaining access to homes and businesses in the area.

We're committed to keeping you informed every step of the way:

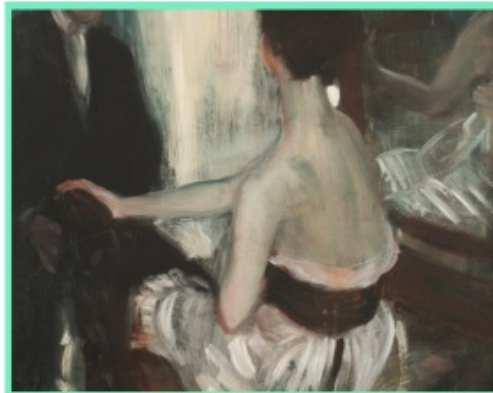
