Our Guest at the April 7 General Membership Meeting will be Raj Verma, Director, City of Fort Lauderdale Department of Public Works.

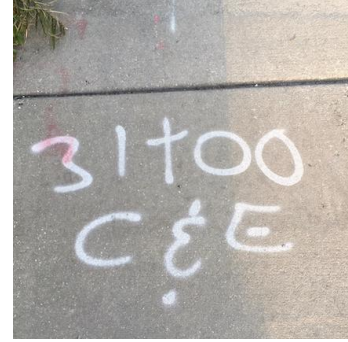
SE 15th Street Sewer Laterals

The City of Fort Lauderdale has been replacing/repairing the sewer laterals from the main line to individual residential properties along SE 15th Street from Cordova Road to the water. Is the project complete? When will the street be repaved and re-stripped?



Sidewalk Markings on Grande Drive

The City of Fort Lauderdale has been planning to replace a section of 6 inch water main along Grande Drive for at least five years. The project, which is designed, permitted and funded, began over a year ago. Then the work stopped. The markings on the street are fading. What is happening????



Finishing SE 10th Avenue

Heading into the final stretch on SE 10th Avenue. The contractor accepted a two month delay while we developed a more costly but Florida Friendly planting plan and a cost sharing proposal.
