Reimagining Huizenga Park

Commissioner Sturman is responding to residents' concerns about the reimagining of Huizenga Park. He was instrumental in including several provisions present in the final lease agreement for the park, which was approved at the January 24th meeting. These provisions include rezoning the area as a park, reducing noise, and mandating a traffic study of SE 1st Ave.

Edgewood & Pickleball Courts

Commissioner Sturman continues to work with residents of Edgewood as well as the applicant for the building of pickleball courts. He is working to make sure that residents' concerns, such as hours of operation, entrance and exit, noise, and the relocation of the recycling center will be resolved in the site planning process.
