

**BCCS Remote Learning Plan  
2020-2021**

BCCS Remote Learning Plan is reserved for students with existing health concerns or who identify a vulnerable population residing in their home. To enroll in the Remote Learning Plan, parents must agree to the following criteria:

- \*Students will make a semester commitment to participate in the Remote Learning Plan.
- \*Students must have internet access at home for this option. It is the parents' responsibility to ensure that their child maintains access to broadband hi-speed internet service throughout the duration of remote schooling.
- \*BCCS has devices available for students who are in need.
- \*Because BCCS cannot guarantee social distancing and health safety precautions in group settings, students electing remote learning may not attend or participate in extracurricular activities.
- \*The classroom teacher may change as BCCS works to balance classes and ensure equity for all of our students.
- \*Students will be expected to attend remote school each day and adhere to assignment due dates just as in person instruction in the regular school setting. The experience and expectations will be different than it was during the Spring 2020 closure due to Covid 19.
- \*Remote learning students must follow dress code.
- \*Parents must agree that any assessments taken by their child will be done so on his/her own.
- \*Grade level promotion criteria will be the same for on campus and remote learners.
- \*Students will follow the grade level attendance policies for remote learning such as logging into live class sessions each day.

**BCCS Primary/Elementary**

Schedule	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Students will be provided instruction for reading, math, and writing</li> <li>● Students will need to participate in daily classroom reading groups via Google Meet from 8:15-9:00.</li> <li>● Students will have at least one 30-minute tutoring session weekly with their teachers via Google Meet.</li> <li>● Students and parents will communicate and upload documentation of work via Classroom Dojo.</li> <li>● Deadlines for work submissions are at the teacher's discretion</li> <li>● While some assessments can be administered at home via Classroom DOJO or Google Meet, other assessments will need to happen on campus and will be scheduled in advance to ensure precautions are in place.</li> </ul>
Attendance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Attendance will be taken based on presence in Google Meet reading groups and work submission deadlines.</li> </ul>
Grades	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Kindergarten- Students will be assessed as normal based on the Georgia Performance Standards and Georgia's G-Kids assessment system. These assessments will be a combination of submissions, Google Meet assessments, and on campus assessment days.</li> <li>● Students will receive grades on any assignments that are administered in the on-campus classrooms. Teachers will provide guidance on which assignments need parents support and which should be completed independently. These assessments will be a combination of submissions, Google Meet assessments, and on campus assessment days. Grades will be uploaded to Infinite Campus in a timely manner.</li> </ul>

Schedule	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students will be provided instructions for ELA, Math, and Sci/SS via pre-recorded lessons uploaded to Google Classroom.</li> <li>• Students will receive at least one tutoring session weekly per subject area via Google Meet.</li> <li>• Assignments will be uploaded and submitted via Google Classroom.</li> </ul>
Attendance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Attendance is expected daily. It will be based on questions completed after viewing the video instruction as well as Google Classroom login information and submission deadlines.</li> </ul>
Grades	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students will receive grades on any assignments that are administered in the on-campus classrooms. Teachers will provide guidance on which assignments need parents support and which should be completed independently. Grades will be uploaded to Infinite Campus in a timely manner.</li> </ul>

### BCCS Middle School (6-8)

<b>Schedule</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Each remote learning student will receive his/her schedule for the semester.</li> <li>• These students will follow the same schedule as on campus students.</li> <li>• ELA, math, science, social studies, learning lab, and connection classes will be included in the schedule.</li> <li>• Students will log in daily to live sessions on time and in dress code.</li> <li>• Instruction will include live stream classes, web-based learning programs, Google Classroom assignments, workbooks, textbooks, and e-books.</li> </ul>
<b>Learning Platform</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Teachers will post all assignments in Google Classroom, and remote learning students will submit all assignments through Google Classroom.</li> <li>• Specific instructions will be given for live stream login.</li> </ul>
<b>Attendance</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students login in live to each class daily. Attendance will be taken at that time.</li> </ul>
<b>Grades</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Teachers will determine which assignments are graded and entered into the Infinite Campus gradebook.</li> <li>• Students are expected to complete all assignments independently unless given specific direction from the teacher to access online resources, parents, and/or other students, etc. Not adhering to the teacher's policy regarding assignments may result in Honor Code violations.</li> <li>• Teachers will set deadlines for submission of assignments; students are expected to meet the submission deadlines or to consult with the teacher in advance of a deadline should the need arise to extend a deadline.</li> <li>• Work not completed, not submitted in a timely manner, or not submitted in the appropriate format/program will receive a grade of zero.</li> </ul>

Grades 9-12

- Reserved for students with existing health concerns or who identify a vulnerable population residing in their home
- Enrollment will be on a semester-by-semester basis
- Courses will maintain the same complexity and rigor of on campus instruction
- Grades 9-12 will access remote learning via Google Classrooms or Google Meet.
- Classes will follow the same daily schedule as on campus classes.
- Students enrolled in the online option will not be allowed to attend school events or field trips and may not participate in extracurricular activities.

Schedule

- Students will be provided instruction for all classes. Instruction may range from live lessons to electronic resources provided by the teacher.
- Students will need to participate in daily classroom instruction via Google Meet
- Students may schedule tutoring sessions weekly with their teachers via Google Meet. Likewise, a teacher may request a student to meet for a tutoring session. 24-hour advance notice is preferred for scheduling.
- Students will communicate and upload documentation of work via Google Classroom, email and other electronic platforms designated by the teacher. Parent email also will be included in the Google Classroom setup to help parents remain informed.
- Deadlines for work submission are at the teachers' discretion.
- While some assessments can be administered at home via Google Classroom, other assessments will need to happen on campus and will be scheduled in advance to ensure health precautions are in place.

Attendance

- Attendance will be taken based on presence in scheduled synchronous classroom and work submission deadlines. It is expected that students will login for classroom instruction daily.

Grades

- Teachers will determine which assignments are graded and entered into the Infinite Campus gradebook.
- At the high school level, students are expected to complete all assignments independently unless given specific direction from the teacher to access online resources, parents, and/or other students, etc. Not adhering to the teacher's policy regarding assignments may result in Honor Code violations.
- Teachers will set deadlines for submission of assignments; students are expected to meet the submission deadlines or to consult with the teacher in advance of a deadline should the need arise to extend a deadline.
- Work not completed, not submitted in a timely manner, or not submitted in the appropriate format/program will receive a grade of zero.
