Sexual Abuse Education Policy

Baconton Community Charter School will meet the requirements of the following bill by implementing age appropriate education in grades K-9. Parents will sign a statement allowing their child to participate in this education. Baconton Community Charter School will be using the recommended resource TARG, (Technical Assistance Resource Guide on Child Sexual Abuse and Exploitation Prevention).

Effective July 1, 2018, Senate Bill 401 requires:

• Annual age-appropriate sexual abuse and assault awareness and prevention education in kindergarten through grades 9 (O.C.G.A. § 20-2-143).

• The provision that professional learning may include participating in or presenting at in service training on sexual abuse and assault awareness and prevention (O.C.G.A. § 20-2-200).

• In-service training programs on sexual abuse and assault awareness and prevention for professional personnel that will be providing instruction in annual age-appropriate sexual abuse and assault awareness and prevention education in K through grade 9 (O.C.G.A. §
