

Christmas Stocking Photo Tutorial

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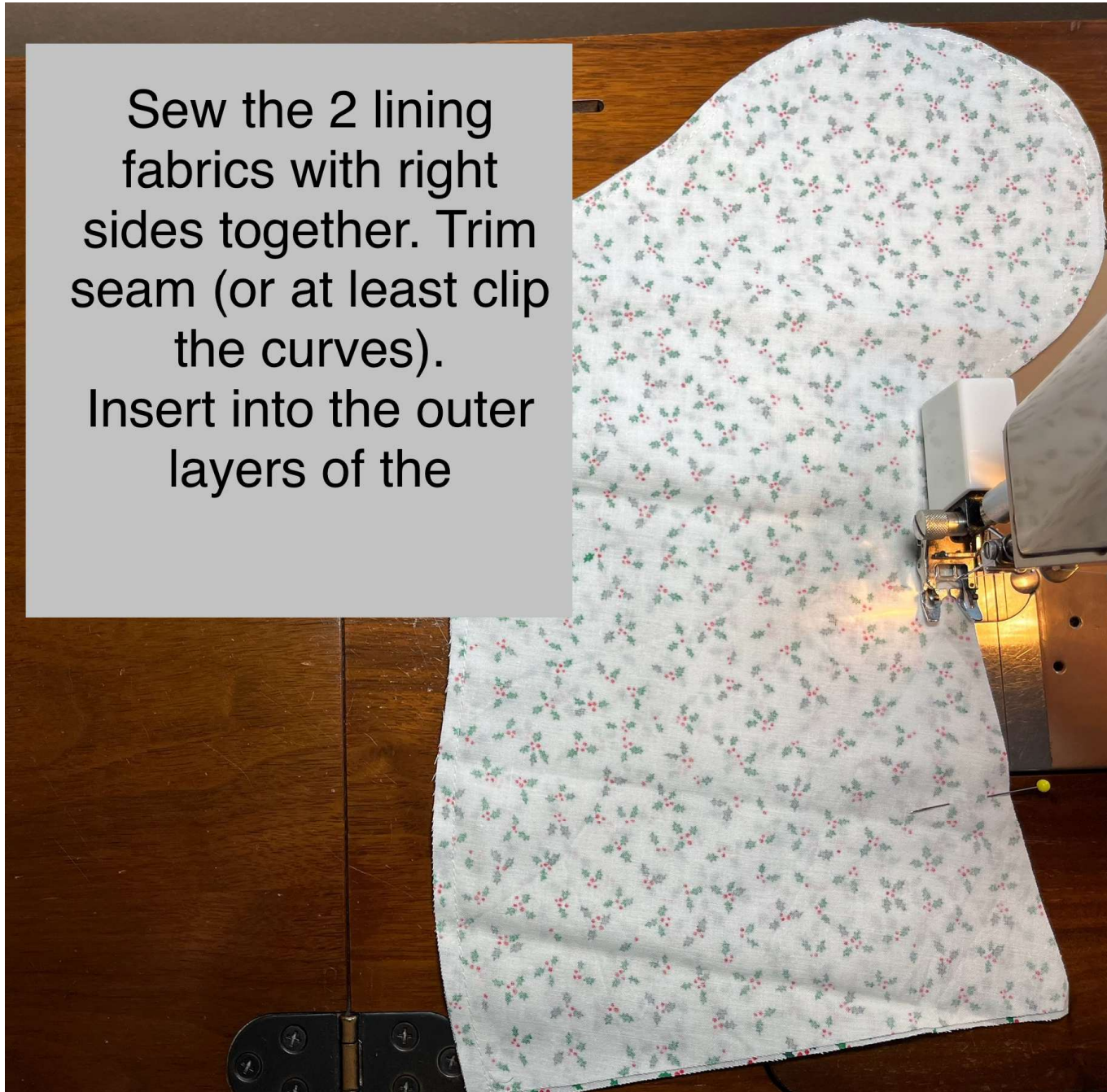
Quilt one layer of outer fabric to one layer of batting (I used straight lines and just eyeballed it without drawing lines)



Sew 2 outer pieces with right sides together, leaving the top edge open. Trim seam, especially inside & outside curves. Turn with right sides outward.



Sew the 2 lining fabrics with right sides together. Trim seam (or at least clip the curves). Insert into the outer layers of the

Fold the cuff fabric
and stitch the
ends with right
sides together.



Trim the
corners
before
turning



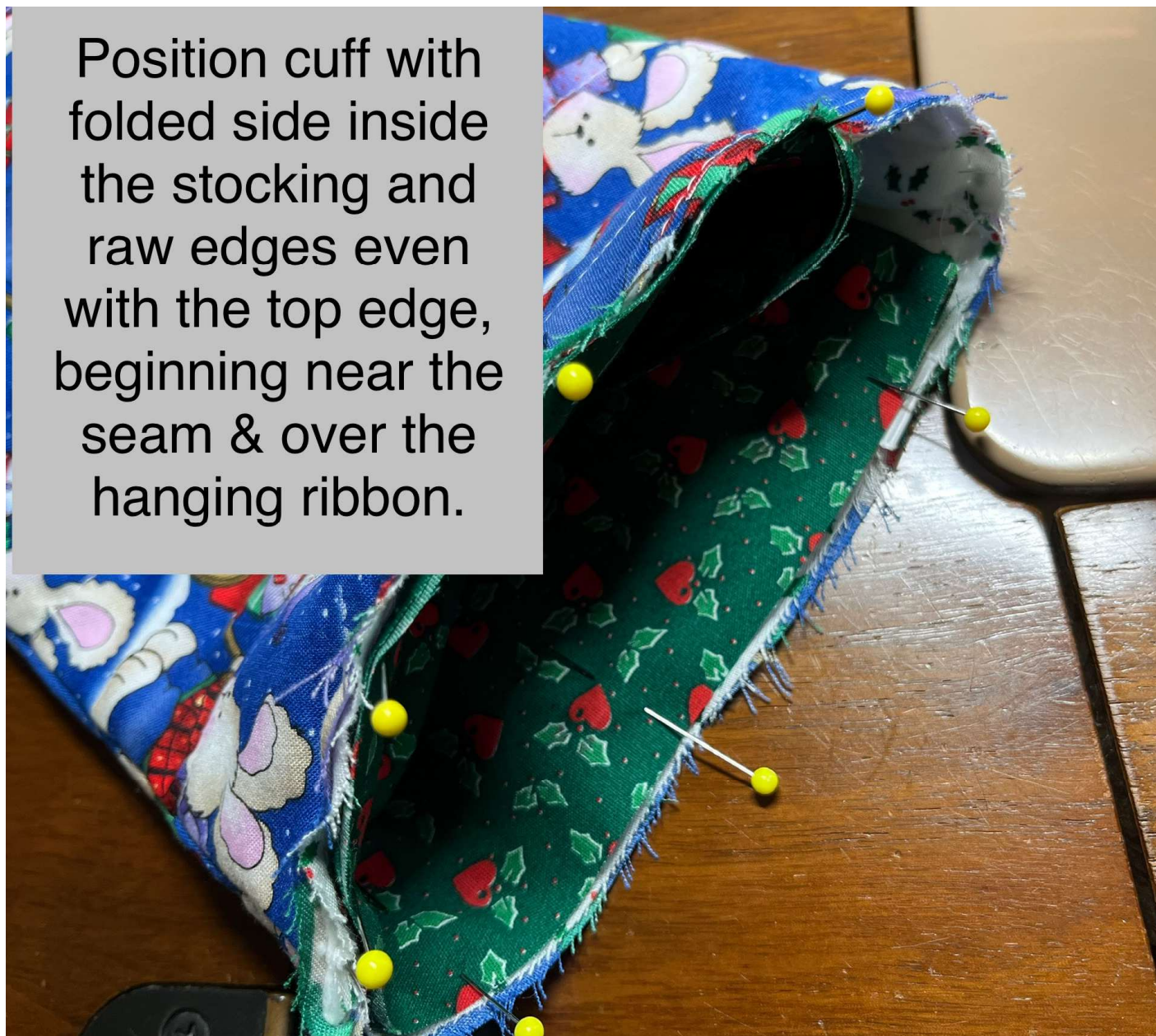
Turn the cuff with
right sides
outward and
press (or
fingerpress).



Pin the hanging ribbon inside the top edge near the side seam with the loop facing inside the stocking.



Position cuff with folded side inside the stocking and raw edges even with the top edge, beginning near the seam & over the hanging ribbon.





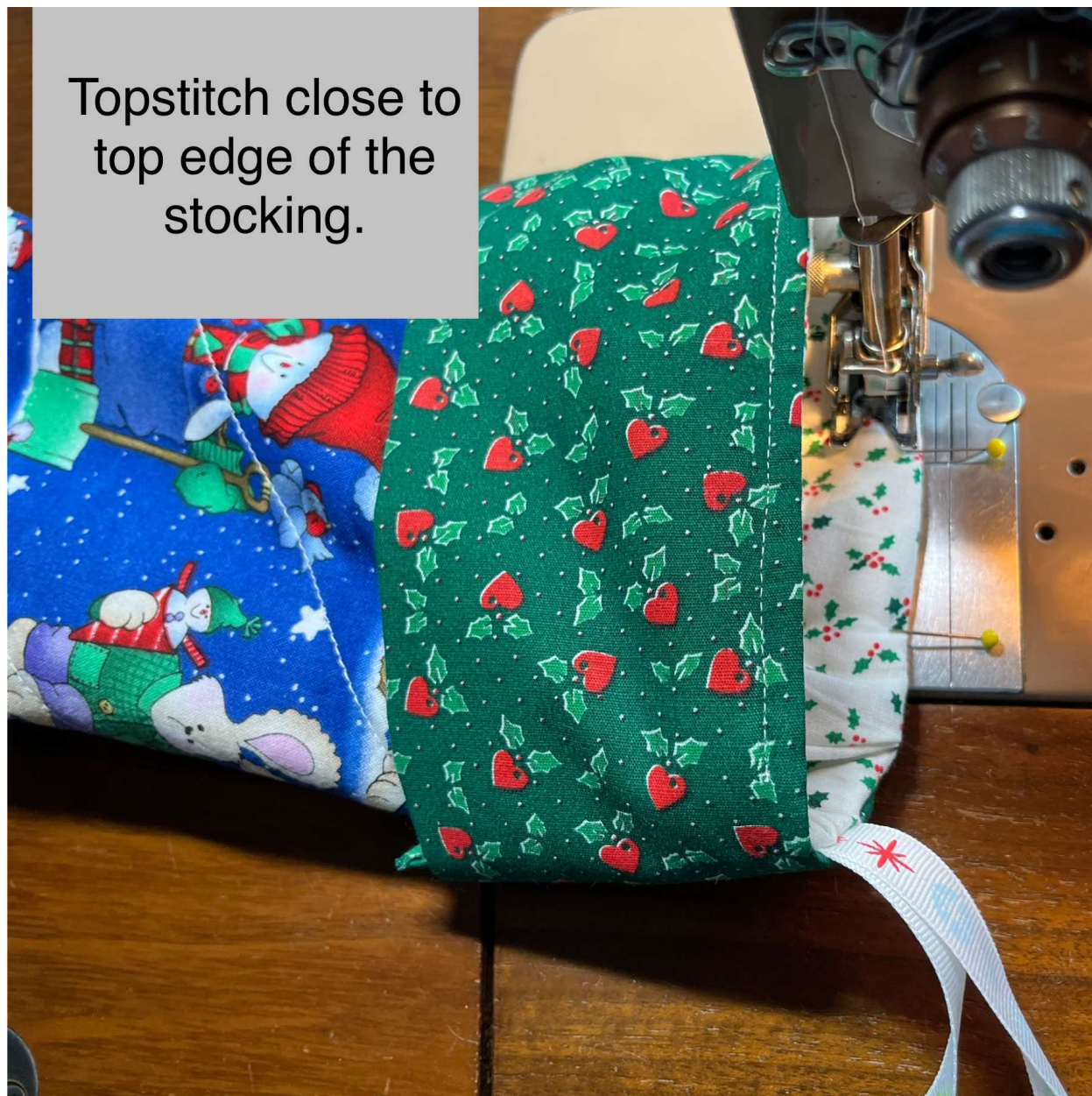
Stitch the cuff
edges to the top
stocking edges on
the lining side.





Turn cuff to
outside

Topstitch close to
top edge of the
stocking.
