CLUE 1

Make 48 half-square triangles (HST) using neutral and medium fabrics. Units will measure 3.5", to finish at 3" in the quilt.

NO RULERS:

These are not my fabrics - for demonstration only -

Cut 3 4" strips of each color. Layer 1 of neutral fabric on top, right sides together.



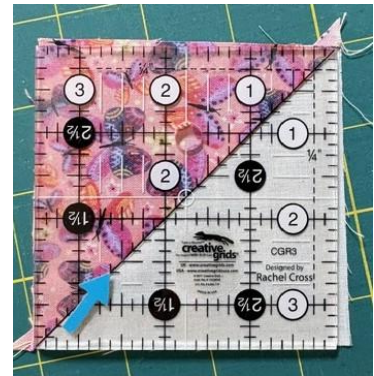
Subcut into 24 4" squares. Keeping pairs together, draw a diagonal line of the back of the neutral piece.



Sew a scant 1.4" seam on either side of the line. Cut on the line.



Open unit and press to medium fabric. Trim to 3/5" square.



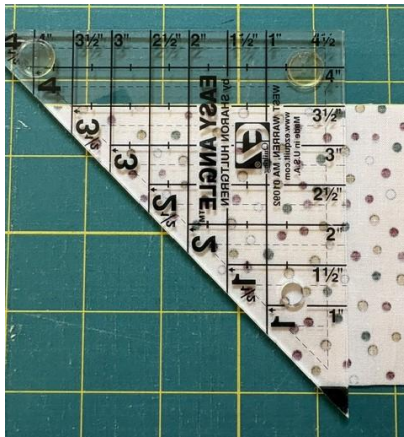
USING EASY ANGLE (or similar)

RULER:

Cut 3 3.5" strips each from medium and neutral fabrics. Layer 1 of each right sides together.



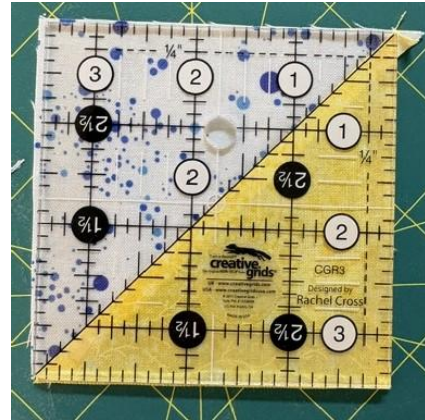
Cut 48 pairs, rotating the ruler as show to continue across each strip.



Sew a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam, open, trim, and press toward medium fabric.



Trim to 3.5" square.



Place all units in a baggie and label as Clue 1
