

GITPO INTRO

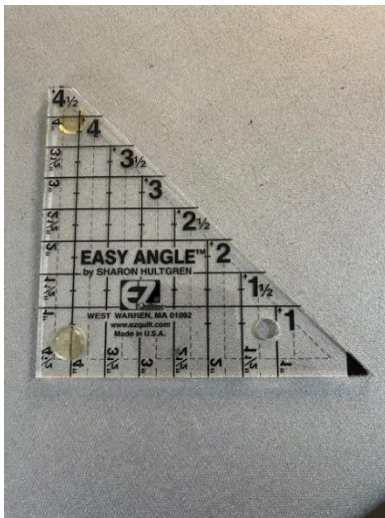
(I'll explain the name at the end...)

This quilt will measure 60 x 75. You can always add more blocks or borders to make it bigger. You have to do your own math for that!!

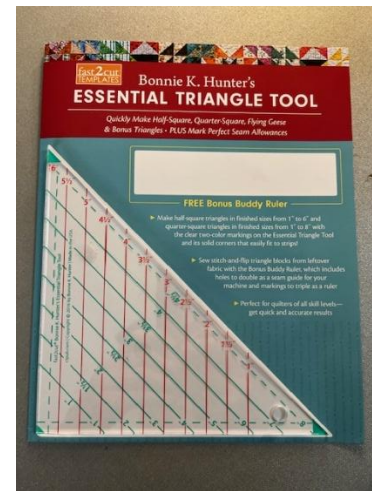
There are rulers you can **use IF YOU CHOOSE**. They can save fabric and also increase precision.

1. EASY ANGLE RULER - used for making half-square triangles

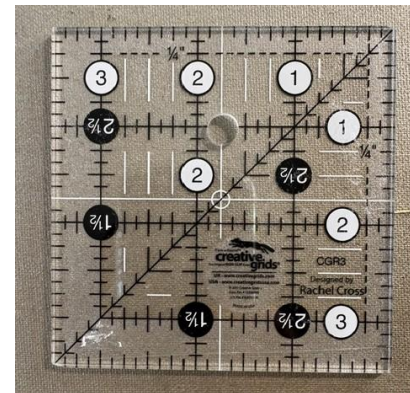
This ruler can be found on Amazon.



2. Bonnie Hunter's Essential Triangle tool does the same job. It can be found at www.quiltville.com



3. I will also be using a 3.5" square ruler for trimming units.



There are many variations to create the necessary units. Use whatever method you like. I will be giving directions for using the easy angle ruler. If you are using something different - **BE SURE TO FOLLOW THE DIRECTIONS THAT COME WITH YOUR RULER**

REMEMBER - NONE OF THESE RULERS ARE REQUIRED. I will give directions for rulers and no rulers.

YARDAGE:

1 - NEUTRAL (background) - 3 YARDS
(my scrappy white/cream) keep in mind that a neutral doesn't have to be white/cream. It can be black, grey, silver, or just a lighter version of your other fabrics - make sure there is contrast between them. You will see at the end that I made a second quilt using light blue as my neutral.

2 - MEDIUM - 2.25 yards (my yellow)

3 - DARK - 1.75 yards (my orange print)

You will also need 8 strips for binding - use whatever width you choose. You might want to include this amount in one of your 3 colors. I suggest either the medium or dark. I chose the dark.

Here are mine: I am using yardage for medium and dark, because I already had it. Feel free to go scrappy - many fabrics for each color, as I am for my neutrals. This is just a small sample of what I'll be using.
