Patriotic Block of the Month

February 2021

Skill Level Medium

And Mercy More Than Life

Finished size of block: 181/2" X 181/2"

Fabric Requirements:

White = 7" X WOF Blue = 7" X WOF

Red = Fourth of a Yard

All seam allowances = scant 1/4"

For reference:

Fat Quarter = 18" X 21"
Fat Eighth = 9" X 21"
Eighth of a Yard = 4½" X 40"

WOF = Width of Fabric

If you love small pieces, try this one



Use Patriotic Themed Pieces:

White (solid or predominantly white)

• (2) - 7" X 7" squares

• (1) - 2½" X 2½" square (center cornerstone)

• (2) - 11/4" X 26" strips

Blue (solid or predominantly blue)

• (4) - 11/2" X 11/2" squares

• (2) - 7" X 7" squares


Red (solid or predominantly red)

• (2) - 3" X 141/2" strips (border)

• (4) - 2½" X 6½" strips (sashing)

• (1) - 11/2" X 26" strips

• (2) - 3" X 181/2" strips (border)



Note - In this picture, there are too many of the white and red 26" strips

Making Strip Units

Sew three 26" strips together as shown (White - Red - White) Cut strip unit into (16) 11/2" X 3" sections





Making Half Square Triangles (HSTs) Using the Magic 8 Method

From two 7" squares of different fabric, you will end up with 8 HSTs Place white and blue 7" squares of fabric with right sides together Draw two diagonal lines on the back of the white square, corner to corner Sew ¼" on both sides of diagonal lines, first one direction and then in other direction Cut square in half, first from top to bottom, and then from side to side Cut the square along the marked diagonal lines, between the seam lines Open squares and press towards contrasting fabric / Trim HSTs into 3" X 3" squares Repeat to make (16) 3" X 3" HST units







Completing the 6½" Square Units (4)

Sew units together as shown, square block should measure $6\frac{1}{2}$ " X $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Repeat to make (4) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " X $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square block units



Completing the Block

- 4 Square 61/2" units
- 4 Sashing 21/2" X 61/2" strips
- 1 Remaining 2½" square

Sew together in rows, pressing all seams towards the sashing strips Sew the three rows together, block should measure $14\frac{1}{2}$ " X $14\frac{1}{2}$ " Add borders, press towards the border strips

Block can be trimmed to 181/2" X 181/2"

The BIG Block

Finished size of block: 181/2" X 181/2"

Fabric Requirements:

White = 9" X WOF Blue = 9" X WOF Red = 9" X WOF

All seam allowances = scant 1/4"

For reference:

Fat Quarter = 18" X 21" Fat Eighth = $9" \times 21"$ Eighth of a Yard = $4\frac{1}{2}$ " X 40" WOF = Width of Fabric



Use Patriotic Themed Pieces

White (solid or predominantly white)

• (2) - 11/2" X 101/2" strips

• (1) - 9" X 9" square

Blue (solid or predominantly blue)

• (1) - 21/2" X 21/2" square

• (2) - 11/2" X 121/2" strips (inner border)

• (1) - 9" X 9" square

• (2) - 11/2" X 141/2" strips (inner border)

Red (solid or predominantly red)

• (1) - 2½" X 10½" strips

• (2) - 3" X 141/2" strips (outer border) • (2) - 3" X 191/2" strips (outer border)



Note - In this picture, there are too many of the white and red 101/2" strips

Making Half-Square Triangles (4 at a time)

From two 9" squares of fabric, you will end up with 4 HSTs (5½" X 5½")

Place white and blue 9" squares of fabric with right sides together

Sew 1/4" from edge around the perimeters of each set of fabric squares

Cut the fabric squares on the diagonal, in both directions

Press HSTs open, towards darker fabric, being cautious not to stretch bias edges

Trim HSTs to 51/2 " squares

Create a total of 4 blue/white HSTs





Making Center Strip Unit

Sew three 10½" strips together as shown (White - Red - White)

Unit should measure 51/2" X 101/2"

Cut strip unit into (4) 21/2 sections (strips)

Each strip should measure 21/2" X 51/2"





Completing the 12½" Square Unit

Sew units together as shown, square block should measure 121/2" X 121/2"



Completing the Block

Add inner borders, press towards the inner border strips Block should measure ≈ 14½" X 14½"

Add outer borders, press towards the outer border strips Block should measure ≈ 18½" X 18½"





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
