## Arranging the Pieces

Arrange the pieces as shown to the right Sew together in the order shown in the diagram Sew Patriotic Center to White # 1, then add White # 2 Then attach → Red # 3 & 4 to the upper left corner Then attach  $\rightarrow$  White # 5 & 6 to the lower right corner Then attach → Blue # 7 & 8 to the upper left corner Then attach → White # 9 & 10 to the lower right corner Then attach → Red # 11 & 12 to the upper left corner Then attach → White # 13 & 14 to the lower right corner Then attach → Blue # 15 & 16 to the upper left corner Press all seams away from the center patriotic square

## Completing the Block

No all-around borders on these big blocks

The pieces on the outside edges of the blocks are made a little wider so that all the blocks we receive can be trimmed to the same size / Because everyone's 1/4" seams are different, the blocks always vary in their unfinished sizes
