

ELECTIONS COMMITTEE

Complies with general guidelines for committee chairs.

Procedures

The President appoints three (3) members to serve at the Annual Guild Meeting (February). If there is more than one nominee presented by the Nominations Committee for a position or as a result of the nominations from the floor, the Elections Committee will be needed to dispense ballots for voting. The Committee will be responsible for counting the votes. Once the elected slate of officers is known, after the count, the Elections Committee presents their findings, in writing, to the President who will announce the new officers for the forthcoming year of service. When the new officers are elected and their names announced by the President, the Elections Committee has the responsibility of immediately destroying all the ballots. Upon completion of the responsibilities of the committee, the Elections Committee is automatically discharged.

Note: The Elections Committee is a sub-committee of the Parliamentarian.
