Join us in celebrating the history and
growth of our Guild membership!

In a continuing effort to celebrate the membership of our Guild, we are continually working on "growing" our "membership quilt". This project serves to recognize and preserve the history of our Guild members and small groups.

Each member will create and contribute a double-sided 10-inch square finished block - quilted with binding. The "Membership Quilt Project Committee" (Tuesday Evening

Nimblers Group Quilters) will organize and stitch our blocks together to create a master "friendship" quilt hanging. This "organic" quilt will be displayed at our bi-annual quilt show as a tribute to our Guild members and their charitable works within our community.

Membership Quilt Project Block Guidelines -

- ❖ Completed blocks are to be double sided - EXACTLY 10 inches square (including binding!) Both sides do not have to be the same pattern/design.
- ❖ One Block per member - (and one block per small guild group).
- ❖ Block design at member discretion - may be pieced, appliquéd, embroidered, etc, and hand or machine quilted (no tacking or tying please).
- ❖ Block must contain member signature and year member joined WPQG - both sides. If block is themed it should be a "Florida" style - all blocks should incorporate the use of a purple (any shade) & white fabric.
- ❖ Block bindings should be tight - corners mitered sharp and no more than $\frac{1}{4}$ " in face width - please use BLACK or DARK fabric for bindings. "Envelope" style blocks are not acceptable.
- ❖ All blocks must contain batting - lightweight 50/50 is recommended. Please use white - bleached muslin - at least 180-thread count if you are incorporating plain white fabric into your block.
- ❖ Remember this will be a large wall hung quilt - that will hang high and will at times be visible from both sides. Solid color or tone-on-tone fabrics are suggested.
