

PRESIDENT

The President shall have such powers as may be reasonably construed as belonging to the Chief Executive of any organization and as authorized in the current By-Laws of the Guild.

Procedures

- The President shall preside at all membership meetings, chair the Board of Directors meetings, and preside at each annual meeting of the organization (February).
- With the exception of the Nominations Committee, the President appoints all committee chairs, and is President ex-officio of all committees, temporary or permanent.
- Ensures all books, reports, and certificates as required by law are properly kept or filed.
- Co-signs checks or drafts of the organization.
- Is versed in parliamentary law, and must be thoroughly familiar with the by-laws and policies and procedures of the organization.
- Guides, advises, and works with all the committees and elected officers.
- Writes an annual report with recommendations and submits it to the Board of Directors at the February Board meeting.
- Provides successor access to all pertinent materials listed above.
