Door Prizes: Donations for door prizes will be collected at the December membership meeting.

Basket Walk: Completed baskets are going slowly. We need to order more tickets, being mindful of the numbering

Block Party: So far there are 10 ready

Philanthropic Quilts: We will be adding 6 more quilts to increase revenue

Small Quilts: As of now we have 50 and are expecting more from the Day Camp

Set up/Take Down: All items from storage will be gathered in one place by Sunday before the show

Table allocation: We need to determine how many tables we need to rent; Scrap Bags and Library are running out of table space.

Public Relations:

We will need 100 Ambassadors

We are looking for other display venues in addition to the *Methodist Church* and The *Art Guild*. Hostesses are needed for the Art Guild. Gerri winter will be asked to offer quilt demos.

City of New Port Richey will mention our show on the website and Facebook, e.t.c. for the months of January and February. Starting January 20 will be declared quilt week.

Sponsors: We need sponsors for the Guild Challenge(\$500), Mystery Quilt(\$300), a new Funeral Home(\$300) and needle and thread (\$100)

Boutique: We currently have \$7000 worth of products, with more to come from Day Camp

Scrap Bags: more than 1000 are ready

Judging: One of our judges has dropped out and we are looking for another. If not, we go ahead with one.

Quilts in Show: total of 210 with 144 to be judged

POS: Do not ring cash on the show floor. Training will be held after November mtg.

QOV: total of 103, 24 being quilted, 9 are finished, and 70 tops are done

Spreadsheet: is completed

Vendors: We have a new vendor this year

Program: Early layout is in progress. There are 50 quilt photos so far

We will have the use of 2 of the city Trolleys this show on Friday and Saturday starting at 10 AM
