Tuition is \$650/month. As we operate without government funding, this supports our independence – with plans for family-based scaling in the future.

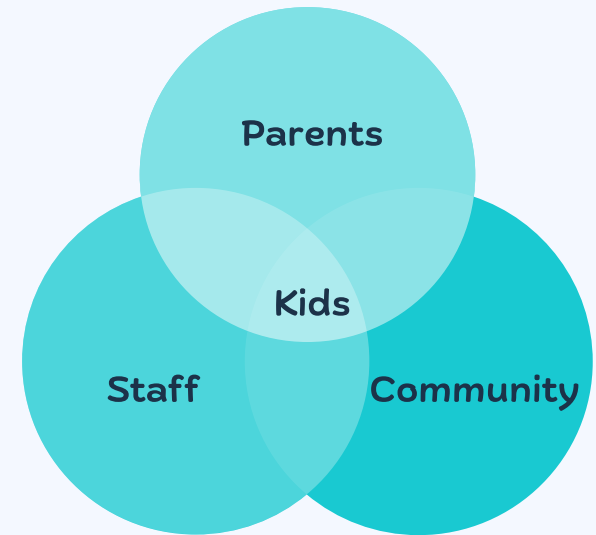
We believe open, clear communication is essential, with parents playing a key role in teaching and preparing their children for the future.
