Beginning Sunday, August 3rd I will be preaching from Matthew's account of the Sermon on the Mount. The Sermon offers us a rich collection of Jesus' teaching on how to live as his followers. Dallas Willard, in *The Divine Conspiracy*, summed it up this way:

What we have come to call the Sermon on the Mount is a concise statement of Jesus' teachings on how to actually live in the reality of God's present kingdom... It concludes with a statement that all who hear and do what he there says will have a life that can stand up to everything—that is, a life for eternity because it is already in the eternal (Matt. 7:24-25).

I'll have printed copies of the text available each week so you can follow along more easily.

I'm happy to announce that on Sunday, September 7th at 3:00 p.m. at the Norris Methodist Church, we'll be launching our ecumenical youth group. Study Group will not meet in August. The group is looking for a new book to study. This would be a good time for anyone interested in joining the group and have input on new study.


Women's Fellowship
