I have just finished reading Jon Meacham's latest book, *Let There Be Light.* Although there are tons of books on Lincoln, this one is unique in that it traces the former President's spiritual pilgrimage from his earliest days until his death. Meacham gives lots of attention to Lincoln's moral development and the role of conscience in many of his decisions. I was particularly interested in the President's awareness of God's hand in events—an awareness that grew out of both his personal suffering and the suffering generated by the Civil War. Meacham's writing is clear and straightforward; as a result, the book is highly readable.

Now to the big screen. Ginny and I recently ventured to the movies to catch the feature, *A Man Called Otto*. Starring Tom Hanks, this dark comedy explores a wide range of human terrain—grief, the importance of friendship, and life and death to name a few. Tom Hanks is superb as the title character, and the supporting cast is outstanding. Otto's story is presented both by means of his current life and illuminating flashbacks. There's a lot in the film that will make you laugh and cry.
