Executive Committee Meeting Highlights

May 13, 2021

All EC members were present via zoom. Lee Borgers and Susan Gawarecki, guest members were also present.

Dr. Bill Ireland, minister, opened the meeting in prayer.

The April EC meeting minutes were approved.

- Alarm System: The decision was made months ago to cancel the alarm system with ADT. However after multiple contacts with the company, the password needed to cancel the service has not been found. Without the password, no cancellation will be accepted. Emily Ott volunteered to contact ADT in hopes of resolving this problem.
- Financial Report: As documented in previous meeting notes, the EC had planned to undertake a "soft audit" of our finances. As a result of further conversation, we plan to move in another direction. We recognize that handling our monthly finances can pose a challenge for our treasurers, especially since our current and past treasurers have full time employment. Thus, we are exploring the possibility of securing the services of an outside accountant who specializes in church finance to manage our bookkeeping, payroll, monthly bills, and reporting for a trial period of six months. Joan Hughes resigned as treasurer in early May. Bill contacted Alliance for Nonprofits. They got back to him with several suggestions and names of contacts to assist us in the matter of hiring an accountant. Susan suggests that we simplify our system into one program instead of multiple programs we have been using. At Sunday's May 16 Congregational meeting there will be a discussion on why the EC believes hiring an outside accountant is the right path to take. Tracy Crouch-Hubbs will make the announcement for the EC at the May 16 congregational meeting. In addition to discussing the hiring of an accountant, Tracy will ask the congregation their thoughts of the future of the Parsonage and talk briefly about the annual ICCC meeting in July.
- Minister's Report: Bill received recognition from the Heifer organization thanking the church for the donation of a pair of cattle and llamas.
- Bill has been in conversation with other churches in Norris about having a community VBS this summer.
- Janitorial Duties: Mary Shelton had a conversation with David Hughes, church janitor. Mary asked
 David for a list of his janitorial duties and he provided one that the previous janitor used. She asked
 him if he would clear out the Nursery room which was cluttered with random stuff and he cleaned it
 up. Dave said the meals he makes and delivers Wednesday is a mission of his but would like to
 make it the church mission. Funds he receives are not of a commercial nature, they cover his costs
 for food.
- Church Pianist: Tracy Crouch-Hubbs applied for the position of church pianist and was accepted by the EC as new pianist as of May 9.

Bill closed the meeting in prayer.


