Financial Report: The Operating Fund is slightly in the black for July. It is in the red for the year. We're having trouble with insurance and getting the payments accepted. We may need to look at a different Broker and different insurance. In August the biggest expense will be the distribution of half of the Benevolence Committee budget.

Ministers Report: Working to launch Youth Group. They'll start on September 7 and the locations for the meetings will rotate. Next week Bill will be out of town as the Academy for Spiritual Formation. He's leaving on the 11th and will return on the 15th.

Member Directory Update – Make changes to simplify so things are easier to find. Bill will hand out forms for people to fill out Sunday in church.

Visitors July 12 & 18 with Breakfast on the 13th – The visitors were well behaved. They wrote us thank you notes. They kept Bill informed and in the loop of what was going on.

New Business: Evaluate Janitorial Service – Office has not been cleaned in a month. Louna will make a list of minimums that need to be done and give to Bill.

Accountant – We talked to Patience Marcum a QuickBooks Certified Bookkeeper. She is a Certified QuickBooks Pro about being our new Accountant/Bookkeeper. She's done Corporate Accountant for several years. She started her own business but has years in Accounting and Finance. She has done tax returns for nonprofit at a CPA firm. Will do as much or little as we want and will work with a CPA as needed. She can do W2's and 1099's for payroll. She does not have any tax software like for quarterly taxes. She will check and see if she can easily do if it can be filed manually. Pay is based on average transactions volume by month and how many accounts need reconciling and payroll.
