

# US OPEN Slalom Double Header - April 19 & 20, 2025

### Race details

This national-level slalom event on the Nantahala is a Southeastern classic. Everyone is invited to compete against the country's top whitewater athletes, including Olympians and National Champions. The weekend will include two days of racing, with each paddler taking two runs per day. The better run each day counts toward the overall US OPEN rankings.

The races will take place on the lower Bridge Gates course (behind the NOC Outfitter Store) and should challenge beginner to intermediate level slalom paddlers. Participants are encouraged to use slalom-specific boats.

The race entry fee is \$30 and includes an event T-shirt.

- Scores will be posted at the finish tent and emailed to participants at the end of the race.
