Leadership Growth Opportunities in Nursing


VIRTUAL WEBINAR

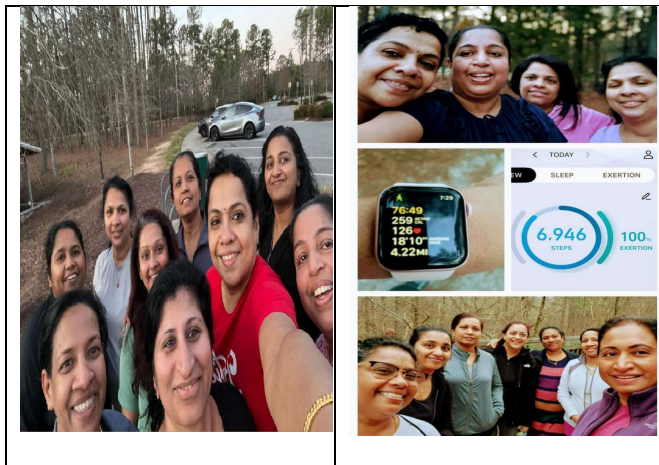
