COURSE DESCRIPTION:

In this webinar, pediatric therapists will learn a substantial repertoire of assessment tools and strategies to individualize the evaluation process for each child in a traditional pediatric therapy setting as well as using a telehealth platform. When evaluating a child, choosing assessment tools and using clinical reasoning to pinpoint a treatment plan for effective outcomes can be challenging for both pediatric occupational and physical therapists, especially when conducting virtual evaluations. You will learn effective methods to perform a pediatric evaluation utilizing a telehealth platform by examining which pediatric clinical observations and standardized assessments can be implemented virtually. Interpreting assessment results involves combining results from standardized test scores, clinical observations, and teacher/parent/caregiver input, then using deductive reasoning to synthesize deficits into a cohesive report that addresses participation in childhood occupations.

This webinar provides pediatric therapists with skills to individualize the selection of assessments, interpret results, and develop an effective intervention program both online and in person.
